## 2019 PROGRAMME COST & LOCATIONS

The Desert Odyssey programme (group and individual sessions), accommodations, meals, and local transport are included in the 7-day residential retreat at S\$1,800 (single occupancy for Nongsa and twin share for LeChaim). Airfare is not included for LeChaim (about S\$600 return). Early registration discount available at least 40 days prior to programme commencement. Discount for full-time ministry and/or charity industry. S\$450 non-refundable deposit to secure a space. Full payment 20 days prior to programme commencement. Option to pay in installments.

LeChaim Retreat Centre in Jeju, Korea, is nestled in the hills of the Pyoseon Oreum district, amidst bucolic surroundings of horse ranches, rolling hills, and healing forests. Desert Odyssey at LeChaim is structured to take in the natural beauty of Jeju. Comprising three UNESCO Heritage sites, Jeju offers the ideal location to experience beauty, explore wonder, and examine possibilities.

Nongsa Point Resort in Batam, Indonesia, is built around a natural cove, and is a 35-minute ferry ride from Singapore. Accommodations are in apartments and chalets designed with a Mediterranean touch. Sunrises and sunsets are spectacular, and a world away to enable us to enter a more sustainable rhythm of rest and reflection.
